Speakers' Profiles

Professor Judith Jones,

Programme Director/Hon Consultant in Oral Surgery, Kings College London/Guys and St Thomas' NHS Foundation Trust, BAOS Hon Secretary, SAC Chair

Judith qualified from The LHMDC Dental Institute with BDS in 1987. She returned and completed a MSc in Experimental Oral Pathology, with a research project on integrins in oral epithelium. In 1992 she was awarded an MRC Training Fellowship to carry out a PhD furthering work on the role of integrins in malignant oral epithelium.

In 1998 she was appointed Lecturer/Honorary SpR in the Department of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery at UMDS. She completed ACCOMS training at GSTT & KCHT and was awarded a CCST in Academic Oral Surgery in 2003, followed by an Honorary Consultant in Oral Surgery at GSTT & KCHT appointment in 2005. She returned to QMUL in 2008 as Senior Clinical Lecturer/Honorary Consultant in Oral Surgery and was promoted to Reader in 2013 and Professor in 2021.

In 2022 Judith returned to KCL as BDS Programme Director/Honorary Consultant in Oral Surgery.

Judith's major interests lie within education and assessment and she has extensive experience in this arena, at undergraduate and postgraduate levels locally and nationally, having been the Lead for Assessment and Lead for the Centre of Teaching and Innovation within the IoD, QMUL, the lead for the OSCE component of the ORE and the LDS RCS examinations, TPD and Chair of the Oral Surgery STC for London and South East.

Judith was an elected Board member of the Faculty of Dental Surgery RCS England where she served 2 terms before demitting in 2021, and also chaired the OS GIRFT clinical coding group who wrote the Outpatient Activity in OS document.

Currently she is an elected member on the Council of the British Association of Oral Surgeons, is the MCN deputy chair for NE London and is the Chair of the LDS examination and the Chair of the Oral Surgery SAC.

Adrian is a practicing Specialist Oral Surgeon who has a Law Degree with an avid interest in teaching. He has worked within Maxillofacial Surgery for over 13 years but also owned a 7-surgery mixed primary care practice in North Wales.

Adrian examines for both the MFDS and Diploma in Oral Surgery at the Royal College of Surgeons of England and is the Deputy Chair of the MFDS RCS England.

Adrian was the HEIW lead for the North Wales Dental Academy and Lead Dental Practice Advisor for Public Health Wales and wrote the Quality Assurance Document for submission to the Welsh Government each year on Dental Practices in Wales. Adrian worked within Welsh Government on the writing of the Oral Surgery National Policies for implementation via Ministerial approval.

Adrian is the Dental Practitioner who gives advice to the British National Formulary for the inclusion medicines added to the prescribing list for dentists in the UK.

Adrian is an expert witness for the MDU and write as assess medical reports for dentolegal cases.
