2024 FDS Research Awards

The Faculty of Dental Surgery at the Royal College of Surgeons of England have announced all the recipients of the 2024 research awards. This year's pump-priming grants and fellowship awards have been given to outstanding applicants.

BAOS teamed up with the Faculty of Dental Surgery at the RCS England to offer a joint pump-priming grant up to the value of £10,000 to fund research in the field of oral surgery that will ultimately improve patient care and the delivery of oral surgery services.

BAOS are delighted to announce this year's FDS-BAOS co-funded Grant was awarded to **Timothy Kwaskowski**, University of Manchester for his research project '*Bone regeneration using dental pulp stem cells in a 3D printed collagen scaffold: An in vitro study*'

This is the 3rd year that BAOS has been involved in the joint scheme which is open to all BAOS members. Entries are judged by FDS RCS Research Committee members and BAOS Council members, with the successful BAOS awardee being invited to submit their research for the Open Paper Competition at the BAOS conference prior to publication.

This year's BAOS judges were Professor Kate Taylor and Professor Judith Jones.

Professor Judith Jones commented "*This collaboration between FDS RCS Eng and BAOS is a great way for both the Specialist Society and the Royal College to support early-stage researchers in getting their projects related to oral surgery off the ground. The applications are of a very high standard and judging them is often a difficult but very rewarding task. I wish Timothy every success with his project and look forward to hearing how the work is progressing in the future.*"
